<b>Collaboration subjects/modules of the Language Assistant</b>	<p>1º, 2º, 3º: one class per week. It is a science class. Prepare presentations and / or informative lessons at the beginning of the unit, then focus on games and projects.</p> <p>4º, 5º, 6º: two classes per week. One science class. Prepare presentations and / or informative lessons at the beginning of the unit, then focus on worksheets and projects. When applicable to the unit, play a game to make the learning fun. One English class that steadily progresses in unit levels. The English class with 6º is one hour long, so there is sample time to learn. In each class, focus on a particular skill or two, making sure to develop all skills within a unit--listening comprehension; writing, grammar and fluidity; speaking,</p>



	pronunciation and confidence; reading, individual and collective.
<b>Information about the town and/or neighborhood</b>	Priego de Cordoba is a beautiful, mid-size town. It is nestled in the Subbetica mountain range, surrounded by olive groves and perfumed by bitter orange trees. The population of the municipality is approximately 23,000. It is very walkable, one end of town to another is about a 30 minute walk, and it boasts a wealth of nearby hiking trails. The Barrio de la Villa is the oldest quarter of town, notably built in the Moorish style with classical Cordobesa patios full of flower pots, right along the scenic Adarve balcony. The town hall is the main center of town, nearby Calle Rio features many cafes and restaurants. CEIP Camacho Melendo is on Calle Ramon y Cajal, a busy street that connects to Avenida de España, one of the main channels through town. Priego has multiple grocery stores, myriad bars, cafes, and restaurants, and a robust local shopping scene. An important cultural rhythm to keep in mind is siesta--most businesses, with the exception of some eateries, Mercadona, and Día, are closed from around 2pm until 5 or 6 o'clock. On Saturday, many businesses do not reopen after siesta. Nearly all businesses are closed on Sunday as well. If a business is open on Sunday, it likely has a different day of the week when it is closed.
<b>Getting to school</b>	It is an excellent choice to live in Priego itself. Anywhere you live in the town will be a short walk to the school. If you decide to live somewhere else, you will have to arrange a sustainable way to commute. Buses between Granada and Cordoba have a limited schedule and weekday service from the cities arrives well after the start of the school day. ALSA services Granada-Priego; Carreras Autobus services Cordoba-Priego.
<b>Accommodation</b>	The average rent for a flat in Priego is about 300€. <a href="https://www.milanuncios.com/">https://www.milanuncios.com/</a> Idealista Easy piso There are many inmobiliarias in town who can help you find a flat for a fee, but it is also easy to find a place on your own with contacts from the coordinator or teachers at school.
